## **BAF** aims to:

- Promote and support the provision of social welfare advice and information services in Bedfordshire.
- Provide a forum for exchanging information on the provision, gaps and resource requirements of advice and information services in Bedfordshire.
- Deliver and support training, in collaboration with BAF member agencies.
- Seek funding for projects to develop advice services relevant to local needs.

### **Our activities this year**

Bedfordshire Advice Forum has been involved in a number of initiatives over the past year, including:

- Facilitating forum meetings for BAF members to network and discuss the issues affecting their service users, and receive presentations from different organisations.
- Leading the Bedfordshire Benefit Network, bringing together agencies to discuss the specific issues relating to benefits, such as Universal Credit and disability benefits.
- Facilitating the **Central Bedfordshire Advice Strategy Management Group** and overseeing the refresh of the **Advice Strategy**, with financial support from Central Bedfordshire Council.
- Arranging training courses and briefings on range of subjects including benefits, welfare reform and Universal Credit.
- Working in partnership with the Voluntaryworks Consortium and developing the Building Better Opportunities project.

Bedfordshire Advice Forum is made up of 30 member organisations from across the voluntary and public sectors.
